2. This pertains to the upcoming 120<sup>th</sup> Philippine Independence Day which will be commemorated on June 12, 2018 through the conduct of various meaningful activities.

3. In this regard, all PNP Personnel who will be deployed during the said activity are advised to strictly adhere to the Police Operational Procedures (POP) and Human Rights-Based Policing (HRBP). Non-conformance to the Rule of Law, POP, and HRBP often lead to human rights violations. Such violation will be dealt with accordingly based on the existing PNP disciplinary rules and pertinent laws.

4. Further, please be reminded of these three Human Rights Obligations, to wit:

- a. **To respect human rights** (which refers to the act of refraining from interfering with the enjoyment of people's rights);
- b. **To protect human rights** (which refers to the implementation of laws that provide equal protection to all persons from human rights violations by state and non-state actors); and
- c. **To fulfill human rights** (which refers to the act of establishing policies, mechanisms, systems, or institutions that enable people to enjoy their rights).

5. Request submit After Activity Report of your action taken **on or before June 14, 2018.**
